



Ukrainian refugees and internally displaced people

OVERVIEW OF THE SITUATION

Since February 24 till the end of March

- Almost 4 millions people left Ukraine and most of them became refugees in different countries
- Almost 7 millions displaced within Ukraine, mostly to relatively safer Western regions
- Around quarter of the population and half of Ukraine's children forced from their homes
- Almost half of million of Ukrainian citizens returned to Ukraine from abroad

Refugees in some countries

- Poland has taken in 2.2 millions refugees
- Moldova received 370,000 refugees, equivalent to about a tenth of its population
- On March 24th President Joe Biden said USA would take in up to 100,000 Ukrainian refugees and contribute \$1bn to help Europe cope with the influx

The immediate refugees' needs

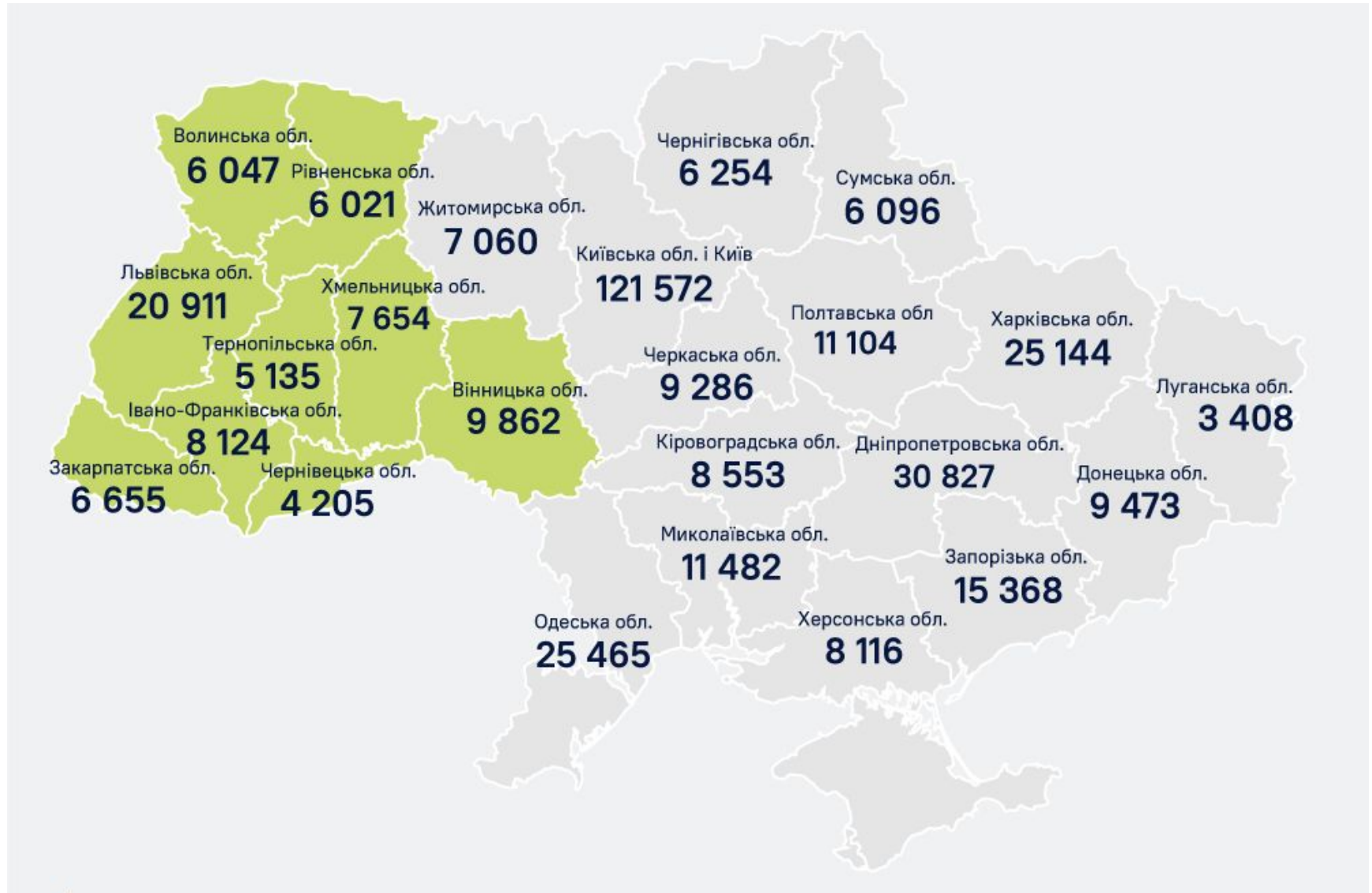
- Safety
